



## APL 8-Ball Information:

In the Amateur Pool League your win/loss record at the end of the session determines your final standings.

1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> place. If your team finishes first, second or third place at the end of the regular session you do not have to play in end of session playoffs.

### BCA 8-Ball National Qualifier (Cities)

If your team finishes 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> they automatically qualify for the BCA National Qualifier

### Regional Tournament (Cash Tournament)

If your team finishes 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> they automatically qualify for the Regional tournament which is held after every session. \*(10) team divisions and above.

### “Best of the Rest” Tournament

If your team does not automatically qualify your session is not over! All remaining teams in the division are eligible for the “Best Of The Rest” tournament held locally at the end of every session. The winner qualifies for the Regional Tournament and a cash prize depending on size of the division.
