



APL 9-Ball Information:

In the Amateur Pool League your win/loss record at the end of the session determines your final standings.

1st, 2nd or 3rd place. If your team finishes first, second or third place at the end of the regular session you do not have to play in end of session playoffs.

BCA 9-Ball National Qualifier (Cities)

If your team finishes 1st or 2nd they automatically qualify for the BCA National Qualifier

Regional Tournament (Cash Tournament)

If your team finishes 1st, 2nd or *3rd they automatically qualify for the Regional tournament which is held after every session. *(10) team divisions and above.

“Best of the Rest” Tournament

If your team does not automatically qualify your session is not over! All remaining teams in the division are eligible for the “Best Of The Rest” tournament held locally at the end of every session. The winner qualifies for the Regional Tournament and a cash prize depending on size of the division.

25 Point Handicaps (2-7)

Mark the pocket for the 9-Ball. All other balls do not have to be called.

All matches are played using a race grid, not by points

No push after break

No 3-foul rule for loss of game

If your team does not win the National Qualifier and you would like to enter the BCA Nationals you can! Your team can pay your way into the team or singles Nationals. One of the benefits for playing in a BCA sanctioned league.
